

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN
AND
KHWENDO KOR**

This MOU is made between the Government of Pakistan through the Economic Affairs Division, (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") and Khwendo Kor (hereinafter referred to as "the Non-Government Organization"), a not-for-profit organization registered under (law) at (Society Act 1860) Registration # 2614/5/2280 and Fata social welfare department and Office at Main Street Faisal Town Opposite Police Colony, Nasir Bagh Road Peshawar.

Whereas the Organization (Khwendo Kor) desires to undertake work for the socio-economic development in the country, particularly in the area(s) of 1) Health, Education, Livelihood, Civil Rights, Humanitarian 2) Social Mobilization, and located in (districts) Peshawar, FR-Peshawar, Noshera, Charsada, Mardan, Swabi, Kohat, Hangu, Karak, Laki Marwat, Bannu, FR-Bannu, D.I.Khan, Tank, Dir Lower, Dir Upper, Mansehra, North Waziristan, South Waziristan, Kurram Agency, Aurkzai Agency, Khyber Agency, Mohmand Agency and Karachi Sindh as well, and for this purpose has submitted an application for registration accompanied by requisite documentary information.

Now, the Government is pleased to allow the organization to carry out its work on the following conditions:-

1. This MOU shall be governed by laws and policies of the Government of Pakistan.

2. **The Government may:**

2.1. Allow (Khwendo Kor) to receive foreign contributions including funds, materials and services, emanating from declared sources, through legal channels, subject to reporting requirements.

2.2. Allow (Khwendo Kor) to open, maintain and operate accounts for the execution of its work.

Provided that for opening and operating foreign currency accounts, the (Khwendo Kor) shall seek permission of the State Bank of Pakistan, under the applicable law and rules;

2.3. Allow (Khwendo Kor) to maintain its office at all offices Peshawar, Kohat, Karak, Bannu, Mansehra, Dir Lower, Dir Upper, and Karachi and to open other offices, if required, with prior written approval of the Government, subject to the concurrence of the Provincial Government / local government and compliance with applicable law / rules.

3. **Import / Tax Regulations**

3.1. The (Khwendo Kor) may avail 100% tax credit subject to the provisions of the Section 100C and approval of the Commissioner Inland Revenue concerned, under Section 2(36) of the
